The department has launched the *Everyday Maths Hub* on its website. It is available to parents and carers to assist you to promote the importance of mathematics in everyday life.

Activities on the website can support you in empowering your children to think critically and creatively, find and solve problems, and notice and wonder about the mathematics in the world around them. The website contains:

- mathematical bite-size content
- short creative videos to introduce topics
- interactive everyday activities
- inspiring reading and resource lists
- games and puzzles

I encourage you to explore the site with your children to help them improve their mathematics understanding. Please remember to use COVID-19 safety recommendations when dropping your children to school and when picking them up. The morning procedures are working well at the school and I thank all parents and carers for their support.

In the afternoons, please remember to physically distance from each other at least 1.5 meters. This is equivalent to 2 arm lengths. Once you see your child please exit the school promptly. I understand that for many parents the afternoon pick-up is an opportunity to socialise with friends, however, I respectfully request that you move to an area outside the school grounds to talk with friends.

The COVID-19 virus is still circulating and we all need to remember to practise COVID-19 safety procedures. Likewise, please do not enter buildings unless it is necessary.



We are all committed to children's safety, so if you notice any unsafe motorist or pedestrian behaviour, please report the matter to Campsie Police Ph: 9784 9399. Please talk to your child about crossing the roads safely including the safe use of pedestrian crossings.

Do your children know their times tables? I recently contacted a high school teacher from Belmore Boys High School who said it is critically important that students in Year 7 know their times tables. Not knowing these simple number facts prevents students from making the progress they need in high school. It is never too early to start so please encourage your children to practise at home and memorise their times tables.
